Educational Visits and School Trips

- A range of educational visits and school trips are available to pupils both inside and outside of school hours.
- For trips taking place wholly within school hours, the school may ask parents/carers for voluntary contributions to meet the costs.
- Although there is no obligation to contribute, unless sufficient voluntary contributions are received, the school may need to consider whether or not the trip is financially viable.
- As a general principle, trips taking place outside of school hours are considered optional and would normally be funded wholly by parents/carers.
- The school will make every effort to ensure no pupil is disadvantaged because of financial burden.

Materials and Equipment

- The school may ask for voluntary contributions towards the purchase of materials for some activities, for example those undertaken in Design and Technology lessons, where pupils may take home and retain items they have made.

Wilful Damage

- Parents/Carers may be asked to pay for damage to school property or equipment where this results from the misbehaviour of their child.
- Parents will not be asked to pay for accidental damage.
